Christiansen will be extending a .50/gallon discount off Jet A. There will be no ramp or landing fees.



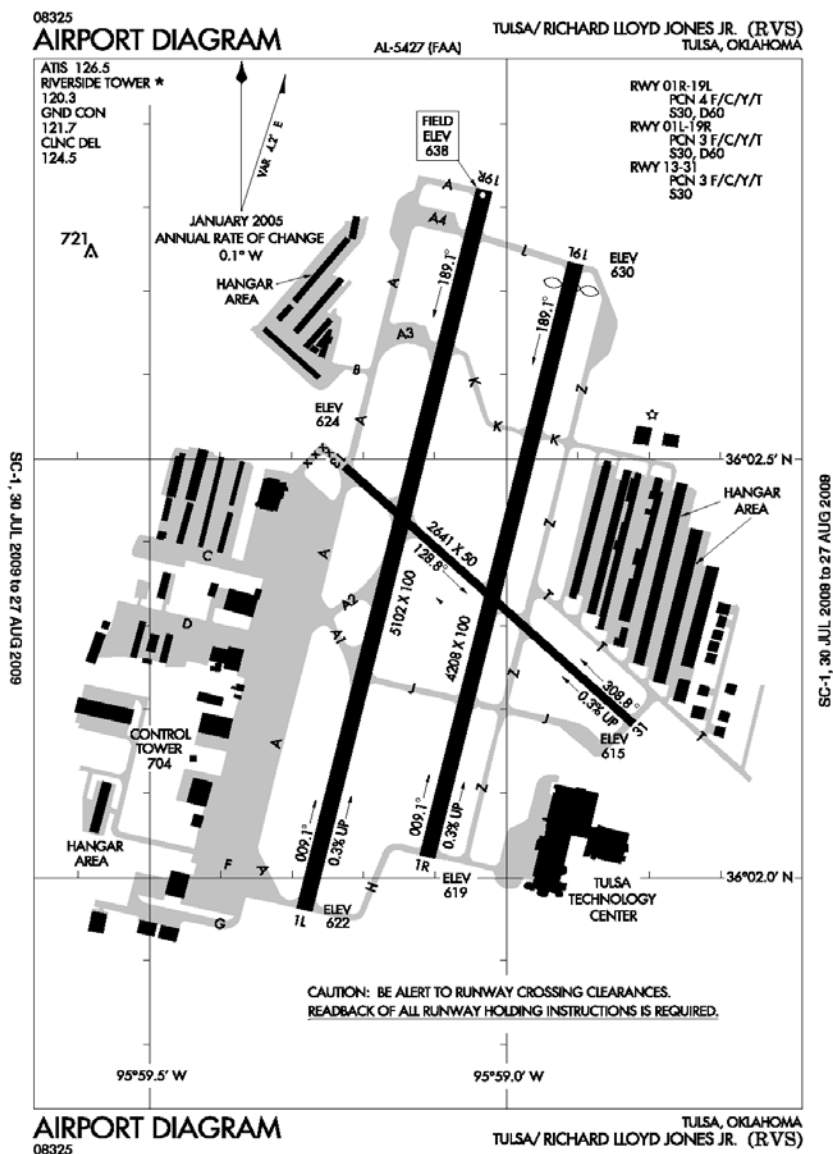
**Transportation Information**

**POPA HERO Squadron**  
**Humanitarian and Emergency Response Operations**  
**“Extraordinary People utilizing an Exceptional Aircraft to Benefit Others”**

We all know that the Pilatus PC-12 is an exceptional aircraft with uncommon capabilities. But, the recent relief effort in Haiti has again proven, the Owners and Operators of PC-12s are a truly extraordinary group of individuals.

The earthquake in Haiti was devastating to the Haitian people in many ways. But one of the most profound was the effect of essentially sealing off the country from transportation sources, particularly large aircraft. In the days following the initial earthquake, rescue and relief personnel and supplies were needed desperately yet access to Haiti’s one major airport was severely limited. Needed were aircraft that had the range to reach the island, the load bearing capacity to supply heavy equipment and teams and, most importantly, the ability to land on short, improvised runways. Very few aircraft meet that criteria, but it is tailor made for the Pilatus PC-12. Those capabilities in themselves make the PC-12 special. But what make it exceptional are the people that own and operate it. And, once again, the Owners and Operators of the PC-12 have demonstrated that they are truly an extraordinary group of individuals.

Some PC-12s began flying relief missions literally within hours of the initial quake with others continuing to ferry people and supplies from the U.S., Bahamas and Dominican Republic in the weeks and months following. Thus far, we are aware of at least 40 individual Pilatus PC-12s that have been involved with direct support of the Haiti relief operations. Individual missions vary but they have ranged from flying in medical and rescue teams, bringing Haitians to the U.S. for medical treatment, to transporting large pieces of x-ray equipment and tents.

POPA and Pilatus Business Aircraft believe the selfless actions of these Owners/Operators deserve our gratitude and acknowledgement. At the 2010 convention, we are pleased to announce the formation of the POPA HERO Squadron. HERO (Humanitarian and Emergency Response Operations) will be an ongoing effort within POPA to coordinate and support future efforts. Part of our mission will be to recognize those who utilize the PC-12 in support of their fellow man.

Squadron inductees will be issued a leather Pilatus flight jacket and those involved in the Haiti relief campaign will receive a desktop presentation piece designed to commemorate their achievements. Both will be presented at the 2010 convention in Tulsa. While we will respect the wishes of anyone who prefers to remain anonymous, we strongly encourage everyone who has supported the Haiti relief campaign to let us know. If you are unable to attend the convention, we will make arrangements to get your jacket and award to you.
